Long Beach and 21st Apartments is a forty-one unit mixed-population community that combines Long Beach Housing Authority (LBHA) and Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) subsidized units with affordable units. Fifteen LBHA and six MHSA units are set aside for people who are homeless and are living with a qualifying disability. Nineteen units are set aside for individuals who earn 60% or below Area Median Income (AMI). Integrated case management services are available on-site for all households five days a week through PATH Ventures and Department of Mental Health (DMH) staff.
